**Patient presentation:** An 81 year-old woman with left breast IDC (ER: negative, PR: 50%, HER-2: negative, Ki67: 30%) with multiple bone metastasis underwent chemotherapy treatment (Palbociclib & Aromatase Inhibitor), but the disease has not responded to the treatment and the contralateral breast is also involved. PET CT scan shows multiple metastases in bone.

What is the treatment plan?

**Recommended plan:**

- Palliative resection with high surgical risk acceptance.
