**Patient presentation:** A 48-year-old known case of IGM, she was investigated because of right axillary lymphadenopathy:

Lymph node positive, ER: 60%, PR: 60%, HER-2: negative, Ki67:25%.

**PH/E:** thickening in UOQ.

**Sonography:** Confirmed fibroadenoma.

**Mammography:** Normal.

**MRI:** Non mass enhancement in UOQ of right breast.

She has undergone surgery (BCS and ALND).

**Pathology:**

Right breast: LCIS, E-Cadherin: negative.

Right axillary: Metastatic ductal carcinoma, 4 lymph nodes, E-cadherin: positive, ER: 10%, PR: 40%, Ki67: 10%, HER-2: negative.
