Patient's Name: G.I

Patient presentation: A young woman with history of reduction mammoplasty and then a mass in left breast.

CNB: Idiopathic granulomatous mastitis (IGM)

The breast abscesses were aspirated several times. Finally she underwent surgery because of persistent recurrence.

Surgical pathology: IDC, Grade: 3, Triple negative, Ki67: 80-85%.

Multiple metastases in lung and liver were seen. She was candidate for chemotherapy (8 sessions).

All metastases disappear after chemotherapy.

Question:

Is palliative mastectomy needed?

Does she need Axillary staging?

Recommended plan:

- Palliative mastectomy
