Patient presentation: A 32-year-old woman with left breast fibroadenoma since 10 years ago referred to clinic due to suddenly increased in size after an abortion in November 2023 (60 mm left breast 12 o'clock in US). The clinical findings suggest the malignant phyllodes tumor but the biopsy showed solitary fibrous tumor (S100, NSE, BCL2, CD34: positive, STAT6: negative).

Question:

What is the next treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

- Suspicious for phyllodes tumor, Radical surgery recommended.
