A 51 Y/O F presented with Rt. breast mass & lymphadenopathy in Lt. axillary (1402)

CNB (Rt. Breast):

IDC III, ER+, PR: 30-40%, Her2:-, ki67: 40%

CNB (Lt. Axilla):

IDC III, ER+, PR:10%, Her2: -, Ki67:60-70%

Bone scan: NL

Abdominal CT: NL

Thorax CT:

Central soft tissue mass & satellite dentistry in right breast,

Irregular cutaneous thickening in lateral aspect of right breast.

Several large LNs up to 56\*44 mm in right axilla, retro pectoral, supraclavicular.

Left axillary LN measured 18\*8mm

She received NAC then underwent Bilateral MRM (according to MDT's decision)(1403/4)

Lymphadenopathy in right supraclavicular appeared during adjuvant XRT, CNB was done:
