Patient Presentation:

A 45 Y/O F

Breast US: (1403/8)

Multiple hypoechoic cortex suspicious lymph nodes in right axilla extended to level 2, the largest measured 28*14 mm with 7.5 mm cortical thickness

Breast MRI: (1403/9)

NO definite evidence of malignancy in this exam. Asymmetrical enlargement of right axillary lymph nodes with proven benign pathology could be related to systemic disease (B2)

Thorax & abdominopelvic CT: (1403/10)

Right axillary enlarged metastatic lymph nodes, right breast skin thickening, and nipple retraction

There is a 12 mm lymph node in level 2 of the left axilla

No clear evidence of metastasis

Rt. Axillary CNB: (1403/2)

Reactive lymph node tissue



Breast MRI: NO mass in the breast

Recommended plan:

CT scan was reviewed: right & left axillary lymphadenopathy & spleen lesion, like a spleen cyst. So breast & axillary, and abdominal sonography were recommended. Then the excision of suspicious lesions.
