Thorax & abdominopelvic: NL

She underwent Rt. MRM

IDC III/III, T: 8cm, Bifocal, DCIS, skin & nipple involved, LVI+

Axillary dissection: 8+/22

macro metastases: 8

extra nodal extension >2mm

Abdominal skin lesion:

Xanthoma, no tumor is seen.
