U/S: Lt, 10 o'clock, non-mass- 22*16*14mm (B4)

MRI: Lt, non-mass, 10 o'clock, 30*19mm (B6)

CNB: ILC with signet ring features, ER: 80%, PR: 70%, Her-2:0, Ki67:7%,
staging CT and bone scan: negative

Question:

Do you recommend neoadjuvant chemotherapy to give patient the chance of BCS rather than mastectomy?

Recommended plan:

Based on tumor histology NACT is not recommended. BCS is feasible now.
