**Patient's Name:** Z.M

**Responsible Physician:** Dr. Alipour

**Patient presentation:**

37 Y/O female with right breast bloody nipple discharge with no palpable mass

**MRI:** right non-mass enhancement, upper mid to far zone, 11 to 1 o'clock, 80\*45\*50mm, compatible with extension of DCIS

VAB: DCIS

**Pathology review:** low grade intraductal carcinoma, micro papillary type, ER: +

MDT-1: Mastectomy and implant was recommended

She underwent MST and ALND (due to positive frozen results) and chose not to do the reconstruction

**Permanent pathology:** low grade DCIS, G1, multicentric and multifocal with largest 38mm, all margins are free but DCIS close to superficial upper-inner quadrant margin

ALND: 0/7

Frozen: 1/4nodes reveals a 4mm focus of metastasis which is not repeated on permanent section.

MDT-2: Decision should be made based on pathology review.

**Pathology review:** DCIS, G1, no stromal invasion

SLNB: small focus of metastatic carcinoma

ALND: reactive changes

Now she is 7week pregnant

What is the treatment plan?

**Recommended plan:**

Chemotherapy is advised.
