Patient presentation:

74 Y/O female with history of breast cancer whom underwent MRM and adjuvant chemotherapy and radiotherapy (1395)

1402:

She developed pelvic pain and after evaluation, it was negative for metastasis then she underwent hip joint replacement

1404:

She reported a small lump in her left axilla which later developed into a non-healing wound

The biopsy was negative for malignancy.



Question:

What is the treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

PET scan showed increased uptake in cecum. So colonoscopy is advised. Re-biopsy should be done from ulcer and debridement and local wound care is recommended.
