Patient presentation:

40 Y/O female,

1403: RT mammoplasty, Right breast mass, U/S: 21*16*12mm mass at 9 o'clock, complicated cyst, MG: B0, Excisional biopsy; pT:6cm, ILC

Post Op MRI: satellite lesion and LAP in right axilla

Re-excision: IDC, multiple fragments totally 4cm and involved margins, axillary dissection: 3/6 involved

Question:

Besides Mastectomy for local control, what is the treatment for axillary; dissection or RT?

Recommended plan:

Complete surgery based on surgeon decision and no axillary dissection is needed.
