Patient presentation:

A 54 Y/O female with two foci of 12mm B4a lesions in her right breast according to MRI which underwent vacuum Bx.

Retroareolar lesion 3 o'clock: sclerosing intraductal papilloma with focal flat epithelial atypia

7 o'clock lesion: invasive mucinous carcinoma, G2/3, ER: +, PR: +, Her2:-, Ki67:10-15 %

Reduction type BCT +SLNB was done, there was not any remained pathology in retro-areolar region but 2 mm mucinous carcinoma remained at 7 o'clock with free margins and LVI negative. 1 SLN was free of tumor

Question:

Does she need adjuvant therapy, especially radiotherapy?

Recommended plan:

The MDT recommended performing endocrine therapy and radiotherapy.
