50 Y/O female with positive FH of breast cancer, right breast mass (IDC, G1, ER:+,PR:+,HER-2:-, Ki67:5%), first performed BCS but due to positive margins mastectomy was performed which showed no invasive component but DCIS.


Pleomorphic microcalcification was seen in left breast which underwent VAB and revealed ADH in first time and LCIS in the second one.

Question:

Does she need adjuvant chemotherapy? Does she left breast mastectomy?

Recommended plan:

Continue endocrine therapy and perform risk reduction surgery on the left breast.
