48 Y/O woman with family history of breast cancer in her mother (45y)

Underwent right breast 10 oc lumpectomy

**Pathology report:** UDH

Four months later, she developed localized peau d'orange in the lower inner quadrant (LIQ) of the right breast.

Initial breast MRI demonstrated no suspicious mass or enhancement, other than peri-areolar edema. Six- month follow-up MRI was unchanged. Despite stable imaging, her skin edema persists clinically
