A 66 Y/O lady with 40 mm right retroareolar invasive mucinous carcinoma, besides 2 other similar masses and a 43 mm axillary LAP, received Letrozol instead of surgery because of inability to discontinuation of Aspirin and Plavix due to recent PCI and also uncontrolled DM and obesity.

In US performed later (6 months) all 3 masses became smaller and LAP vanished. In her latest US all 3 masses are stable in size.
