62 Y/O female, left breast mass (15\*12mm),  
1399: BCS + SLNB, IDC, G2, LVI: neg, luminal A, Ki 67 < 15%, Sentinel node:  
0/6

4 sessions of Chemotherapy + 16 sessions of RT

Endocrine therapy with letrozole then after

6/1404, CT: pleural nodule 4 mm on left and 3mm on right

PET scan: mediastinal, hilar and parasternal lymph node

PET scan review: second rib 5\*3 mm SUV: 3.6

Multiple reactive nodes in left hilum, 2 left internal mammary node

Biopsy is taken from paraaortic node: metastatic carcinoma breast origin,  
triple negative, Ki67:20%

**Question:**

Is it a paraaortic or internal mammary lymph node?
