50 Y/O female, right breast,
CEM: 13*6mm mass at 11-12 o'clock (B4c), two non-mass enhancement at 9 o'clock

Biopsy report:

A-6 o'clock microcalcification (B4),
B-non-mass lesion at 11 o'clock, near zone (B4),
C-non mass lesion at 10-11 o'clock far zone (B4),
D and E: VAB from Lt central breast (B4)

Pathology:

A: fibroadenomatoid change with sclerosis
B: benign adenosis
C: intraductal papilloma without atypia
D: DCIS
E: breast tissue and stromal fibrosis

Recommended plan:

General recommendation is to make decision with shared decision making with patients for
a) Wire excision
b) Mastectomy
