Patient presentation:

34 Y/O female referred with skin lesion on Rt breast and biopsied

Pathology report: invasive nests of malignant epithelial cells in dermis not invading epidermis

Pathology review: skin involvement by ductal carcinoma, ER: 15%, PR: 25%, HER-2: +3, Ki67:20%

8 sessions of NACT

MG: Rt: skin thickening, diffuse linear microcalcification (B6), Lt: normal

U/S: Rt breast, 20*6mm non-mass lesion, right axilla: normal, left breast: normal, left axilla: one suspicious LN in left

Left axillary LN is positive in FNA

What is the treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

She is candidate to perform bilateral MRM.
