**Patient presentation:**

52 Y/O female with left breast cancer 6 years ago with adjuvant chemotherapy and radiotherapy

**1402/12, Brain MRI:** 27\*34mm right cerebellar hemisphere metastasis which underwent tumor resection+ duraplasty+ cranioplasty (metastatic carcinoma of breast origin, ER: 50%, PR:30-40%, HER-2:3+)

**1403/03, Bone scan:** wide spread bone metastasis

**1403/08, CT:** sternum, C7, 1,5,6,8 ribs, left iliac, left sacrum, left femur, L4 have metastasis

**1404/03:** spiculated masses in both breasts, 35mm in right (B5) and 30mm in left (B6) with bilateral suspected axillary lymph nodes.

Multiple ulcers in both breasts from 6 months ago

**Question:**

Is she candidate for palliative mastectomy?

**Recommended plan:**

She is not a candidate for palliative mastectomy.
