Patient presentation:

28 Y/O female with positive history of breast cancer in mother (49 y/o)
U/S: right breast, 10 O'clock, 10*8mm (B4c), IDC, ER: 90%, PR: 70%, HER-2: +2, Ki67:25%

MRI: Rt, 10 O'clock, 28*21*23mm, UOQ, far zone + suspicious internal mammary node

Previous MDT recommended performing targeted U/S of right breast+ FISH test+ internal mammary node biopsy
Intramammary node was assessed by mistake and it was reported normal

Question:

What is the treatment plan?

Recommended plan:

MDT recommended performing a targeted U/S for internal mammary node and performing biopsy of any suspected lesion of the right breast.
