Patient presentation:


58 Y/O female with history of right BC 6 years ago who underwent BCS+ALND and adjuvant CRT.

During F/U erythematous skin lesions in Rt breast, biopsy: IDC, ER-, PR-, HER-2:+3, Ki67:60-70%,

FCMV: group of microcalcification in UOQ (B4b),

Target U/S: suspicious LN in supra and infraclavicular bone scan: right hip lesion which was new comparing to previous study but MRI ruled out metastasis

PET scan: omental and Rt paracolic gutter soft tissue density nodules chemotherapy was given and all skin lesions are resolved



Question:

Is she candidate for surgery?

Recommended plan:

Suspicious metastatic lesions and omental seeding is seen in CT scan. Supra and infraclavicular LN is not pathologic. The MDT recommended to perform upper GI endoscopy and colonoscopy.

Perform a CT-guided biopsy of omentum and paracolic gutter nodules and if it is not possible perform diagnostic laparoscopy.

Meanwhile anti-HER-2 treatment should be continued.
