Patient presentation:

40 Y/O female with breast mass during pregnancy which caused Rt breast dimpling in retroareolar region

U/S after delivery: B4c lesion (ILC, ER: 30%, PR:-, HER2:-, Ki67: 35%)

However, there was a 9*6mm lesion in Lt breast at U/S of 1403 (B4c) which was reported as a simple cyst (B2) in U/S of 1402 and no biopsy was taken from it.

She underwent NACT and U/S after it revealed complete response of Rt breast and a cyst in left breast (B2)

Question:

What should be done regarding left breast lesion?

Recommended plan:

MDT recommended to perform a target U/S of left breast and genetic testing. MRI is not efficient as the patient is status post NACT.
