**Patient presentation:**

34 Y/O with mass feeling in both breast (1401), U/S: Rt: 43\*95mm and Lt: 11\*5mm lesions both compatible with papilloma

CNB showed intraductal papilloma with questionable atypia which underwent bilateral lumpectomy (Rt: papilloma, Lt: FCC)

During F/U, she developed a B4a lesion based on U/S which is not biopsied.

**Question:**

Is she candidate for bilateral nipple sparing mastectomy?

**Recommended plan:**

Microcalcifications in MG are diffuse and benign type. MRI revealed non-mass enhancement of probably benign.

MDT recommended close F/U and VAB if a lesion was found in targeted U/S.
